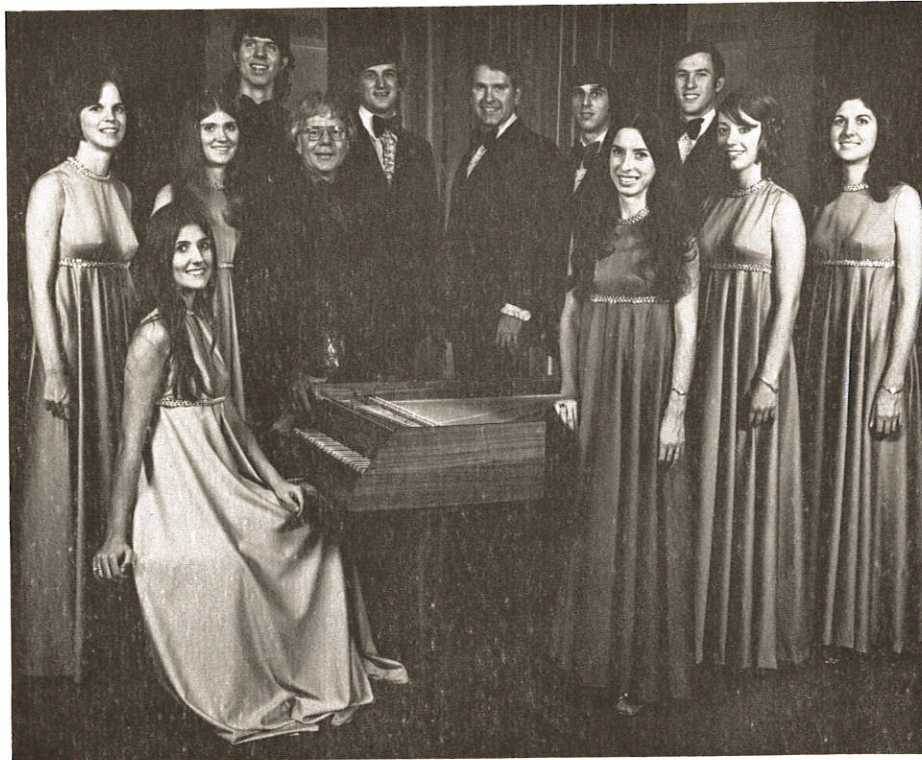

Planned to serve primarily the graduates of community colleges and transfer students, The University of West Florida offers junior, senior, and graduate level courses exclusively.

This co-educational University was established in 1963. Current enrollment stands at about 3,500 including graduate students. About 80 per cent of these are graduates of Florida's community colleges. The University of West Florida is one of the nine units of the State University System of Florida.

In addition to the main 1,000 acre campus located on the banks of the Escambia River northeast of Pensacola, the University also owns 175 acres of beach property adjacent to the Gulf Islands National Seashore on Santa Rosa Island southeast of the city.

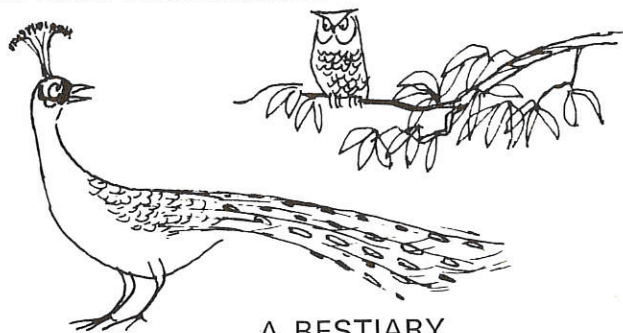

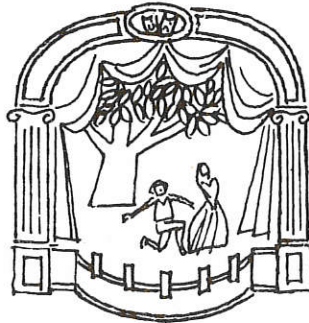
